

Lecture: The Healing Ministry of John the Beloved

The ancient astrologers were not those who had discovered a system of correspondences and applied it to individuals for selfish looks at their patterns or even in sharing with one another to have something to talk about over a coffee table.

The ancient astrologers were those that knew that they could see the pattern of the thought of God. They could see how He thinks and how that relates to the universe. They could establish awareness of universal law and get in contact with it by watching the heartbeat of God, for the movements of the universe were the metabolism of Adam Kadmon, or the expression of God.

And to know Christ, one would see His movement through the heaven and the effects of those movements upon men. Astrology properly is the study of that and understanding self in relation to it by knowing that we are the microcosm that is a reflection of the macrocosm, and what it does we naturally have a tendency to do because we are a part of it, but for one thing.
