

A Question of Morality

The important thing for each of you to remember in questioning your own morality is this one principle:

If an act, or thought, or attitude, or neglect of an act causes harm or hurt to any other entity in your plane of existence, it is wrong.....

Question: How can we reconcile hurts that we have caused other people?

Answer: Your only recourse on the present plane of existence is to attain a higher spiritual level and spiritual values in your life that you may grow beyond the desire to retaliate when hurt or the desire to obtain things of fleshly nature through hurting others. There may be nothing that can be done to repay hurts already caused, except these will form part of the karmic pattern of your existence. The overcoming them through spiritual growth is the importance. This in itself is retribution.

We would answer, at this time, the question you were afraid to ask as to morality in regard to sex. Those acts are wrong that disappoint others in your relation to them. For example, those acts (are wrong) that would cause a person who deeply loves and trusts another entity to be unfaithful to that one he loves. Those acts are wrong that are not shared in love. Those acts are wrong that are selfish.

Those acts are good, however, that cause a sharing between two souls. The perfection of love is in making one another happy. In whatever manner this may be obtained, it is good and blessed.

It is the selfishness of an act that makes it wrong. Therefore, enter into what you do with another entity with love in your heart and with his satisfaction as your goal. Make it a sharing together, and it is right. Remembering, however, as has been stated, that that act is wrong which disappoints the other person in his own principles or his principle of faithfulness to a loved one.

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
