## Homosexuality

Question: Where does homosexuality fit into my life?

Answer: It is important to understand the karmic nature of such relationships for this one to understand any answer given to this question for we would find that there often has been given from these records, from these planes, that homosexuality, or tendencies thereto, came from those karmic relationships where one was being forced to react in a situation of rejection.

We find in this generation, however, that there are very different reasons for entering such relationships, and rather than being viewed negatively or as breaking Divine laws, as has so often been interpreted by those religious or spiritual leaders, this, in this generation, in this time, can be a portion of growth. Not that these are being advocated as a means of growth, but the reasons for such developments should be searched and understood that these are breaking down of polarities.

Then if you would enter into such relationships or consider them, see them as the developing of understanding between individuals, between souls, rather than the satisfying between bodies. Let your relationships transcend the body, then they will be not homosexual or heterosexual, but love relationships. Not bound; not structured. It would be a portion of growth that one would be able to say, in the heart, that he is not bound or cannot do this or that, but follows that which he is led to.

There could easily be the understanding of that which is given from these records as advocating this type of relationship. Careful that you do not do so, for we are not suggesting homosexuality either as an alternative lifestyle or as means of growth. We are suggesting that there is a growth process in which there can be the transcending of differences of polarities. These often can be misused and manifest then as sexual excess. Then recognize love between individuals of the same sex for what it is, and for its purpose. It is given that there might be closer interpersonal relationships and less of rejection between individuals Then in whatever relationship you would enter into, enter with respect for self and for the mate, and no man may condemn you.

As what it will play in this particular life, always there will be the attracting to and from these individuals, or those who accept or have such tendencies. This does not mean there need be such relationships developed, but mutual respect and

understanding Never condemn; never judge. Give only when there is felt genuine concern.
